Committee Role Profile

COACHING LEAD

Introduction

The following role profile is not intended to be comprehensive, nor is it an expectation that potential volunteers will possess all the skills/personal qualities listed. However, the Coaching Lead will have sound knowledge of a management committee.

The role of the Oxfordshire Development Board Coaching Lead is held by the elected official for two years.

This role profile should be read in conjunction with the Oxfordshire Netball Management Committee – Roles, Skills and Personal Qualities document which outlines the requirements of all ONBD officers.

The Coaching Lead's role is to:

- Report to the Chairperson
- Be responsible for improving standards of coaching within Oxfordshire Netball by providing an opportunity for the continuous updating of knowledge and skill.
- Advocate EN's coaching education programme.
- Act as a communication link between Oxfordshire's netball coaches and the ONDB.
- Liaise between EN, South Region, Registered Member Leagues, subcommittees and ONDB.
- Guide, coordinate and chair meetings of the Coaching subcommittee where necessary.
- Prepare a report of the year's activities for the AGM.
- Represent Oxfordshire Netball at the South Coaching TSG
- Champion the ONE Awards relating to Coaching.

Skills/Personal Qualities of the Coaching Lead:

A Coaching Lead is required to have good communication, interpersonal and leadership skills. This role will suit someone with initiative and drive who is able to work in partnership with others, is good at teambuilding and can delegate.

An aspiring Coaching Lead will need to be willing to chair meetings and ensure that decisions are taken and followed-up. They will need to be strong networker with knowledge of Oxfordshire Netball's key networks and be prepared to speak clearly and succinctly as the public face of Oxfordshire Netball.

The Coaching Lead will ideally be a qualified coach and have knowledge of the EN coaches' education programme.
